#### **Annual Parish Meeting**

Saint Paul's Annual Parish Meeting was held on Sunday, January 31, 2021 in the church sanctuary following the 9:00 a.m. service. Myra Ambrogi and Nora Walden participated in the meeting through ZOOM. Highlights of the meeting include:

- Senior Warden Alisha Knox opened the Annual Meeting with a prayer.
- Due to being unable to locate a hard and electronic copy of our parish bylaws, the last version was reviewed by the parish. After reviewing the bylaws, a motion by Robin Hoffman, seconded by Joyce Walason to re-adopt the amended bylaws passed unanimously.
- Voting List for 2020 was reviewed. A motion by Brenda Berndt, seconded by Joyce Walason to accept the voting list passed unanimously.
- The minutes of the 2020 Annual Meeting were read. A motion was made by Joyce Walason, seconded by Ernest Smith to approve the minutes was unanimously approved.
- Alisha briefly discussed the 2020 Parish Register.
- Each Officer and respective Ministry leader presented their reports for 2020.
- Treasurer David Hoffman gave the Treasurer's Report for 2020. Income for 20209 totaled \$55,916.92. Disbursements for 2020 totaled \$36,856.67 for a net of \$19,060.25 for the year. In addition, David reported that we were able to meet our financial obligation to the Diocese for 2020 and paid our financial obligation to the Diocese for 2017 in which we were in arrears
- Pledge Secretary Alisha Knox reported for 2021 there are 22 pledging units and 18

- non-pledging units. Total pledged for 2021 is \$27,300.00.
- David Hoffman presented the Vestry approved Budget for 2021 which includes total income of \$48,740.00 and disbursements of \$48,727.67 for a projected net of \$12.33.
- for Officers Nominations and Vestry members for 2021 were presented. The nominations were; Senior Warden. Kathy Dubois (2 year term); Junior Warden, Greg Berndt (1 year, to fill the rest of Juanita Benoit's term); Treasurer, David Hoffman; Vestry, Myra Ambrogi (2 year term to fill the rest of Greg Berndt's term). The position of Clerk of the Vestry was open. After discussion, Myra Ambrogi agreed to a 1 year term. Glenn Bouthillier agreed to be our Alternate Delegate to Convention. ;A motion by Joyce Walason, seconded by Brenda Berndt was passed unanimously.
- The date for next year's Annual Meeting was set for the Sunday, January 30, 2022.
- A motion by Ernest Smith, seconded by Brenda Berndt to adjourn meeting was passed unanimously.

# Lent Begins with Ash Wednesday

Ash Wednesday marks the first day of the season of Lent which begins 40 days prior to Easter (Sundays are not included in the count). Lent is a time when many Christians prepare for Easter by observing a period of fasting, repentance, moderation and spiritual discipline. Ash Wednesday derives its name from the practice of placing ashes on the foreheads of adherents as a celebration and reminder of human mortality, and as a sign of mourning and repentance. The ashes used are typically gathered from the burning of the palms from the previous year's Palm Sunday. The bible does not mention Ash Wednesday or the custom of Lent, however, the practice of repentance and mourning in ashes is found in 2 Samuel 13:19; Esther 4:1; Job 2:8; Daniel 9:3 and Matthew 11:21.

Proper Liturgy for **Ash Wednesday** with Imposition of Ashes will be on **Wednesday**, **February 17th** and will begin at **7:00 p.m.**
